**UNOPPOSED MOTION TO CONTINUE THE DEPOSITION OF  
PRESTON DAVID PINKETT, II**

**COMES NOW** Roy M. Terry, Jr. as duly appointed receiver (“Receiver”) for International Fiduciary Corp., S.A., and after consultation with counsel for Preston David Pinkett, II (“Pinkett”), files this unopposed motion to continue the deposition of Pinkett, and in support thereof states as follows:

1. The Order entered June 6, 2007 (the “Order”), states in the relevant part:

the Court orders Mr. Preston David Pinkett, II to produce written answers to the questions posed and the documents which support the answers concerning deficiencies identified by the Receiver in his May 30, 2007 letter (excluding parts 1a and b of that letter) . . . It is further

**ORDERED** that the deposition of Mr. Preston David Pinkett will take place from 9:30 AM to 5:30 PM on June 15, 2007 and June 22, 2007 (and such other dates as are necessary) at a place mutually agreeable to the parties.

Order at 2-3 (June 6, 2007)(footnote omitted).

2. To date, the day before the depositions were scheduled to begin, the Receiver has not received any answers or documents as contemplated by the Order entered June 6, 2007.

3. Pinkett's counsel asserts Pinkett needs additional time to produce written answers and documents pursuant to the Order.

4. The Receiver desires to have such answers and documents produced by a date certain that is prior to the deposition.

5. The Receiver has discussed with Pinkett's Counsel the specific relief sought in the prayer for relief, and Pinkett does not oppose entry of an order granting the relief requested.

**WHEREFORE**, the Receiver requests that the court enter an order substantially in the form attached a) granting this unopposed motion, b) ordering that Pinkett must produce sworn written answers and documents pursuant to the Order at the Receiver's place of business not later than 5:00 p.m. on June 19, 2007, and c) ordering that Pinkett's deposition will take place from 9:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. July 12, 2007 and July 13, 2007 (and such other dates as are necessary) at a place mutually agreeable to the parties.
