

3. After further review of the facts and circumstances of this case, the Receiver has deemed it appropriate to withdraw his Motion for Substantive Consolidation of International Fiduciary Corp., S.A. Virginia and International Fiduciary Corp., S.A. Belize (the "Motion for Substantive Consolidation") because, as of the date of the freeze order entered by this Court, all known funds of IFC were held in accounts of IFC Virginia and, as of the date hereof, no case or controversy has arisen involving IFC Belize.

4. For clarity, the Receiver hereby seeks to withdraw, without prejudice, his Motion for Substantive Consolidation and this Motion to Withdraw should in no way impact his pending Motion for Entry of Amended Order Appointing Receiver Over Defendant International Fiduciary Corp., S.A.

WHEREFORE, the Receiver respectfully requests this Court enter an order, substantially in the form of Exhibit A attached hereto, allowing withdrawal, without prejudice, of the Receiver's Motion for Substantive Consolidation.


